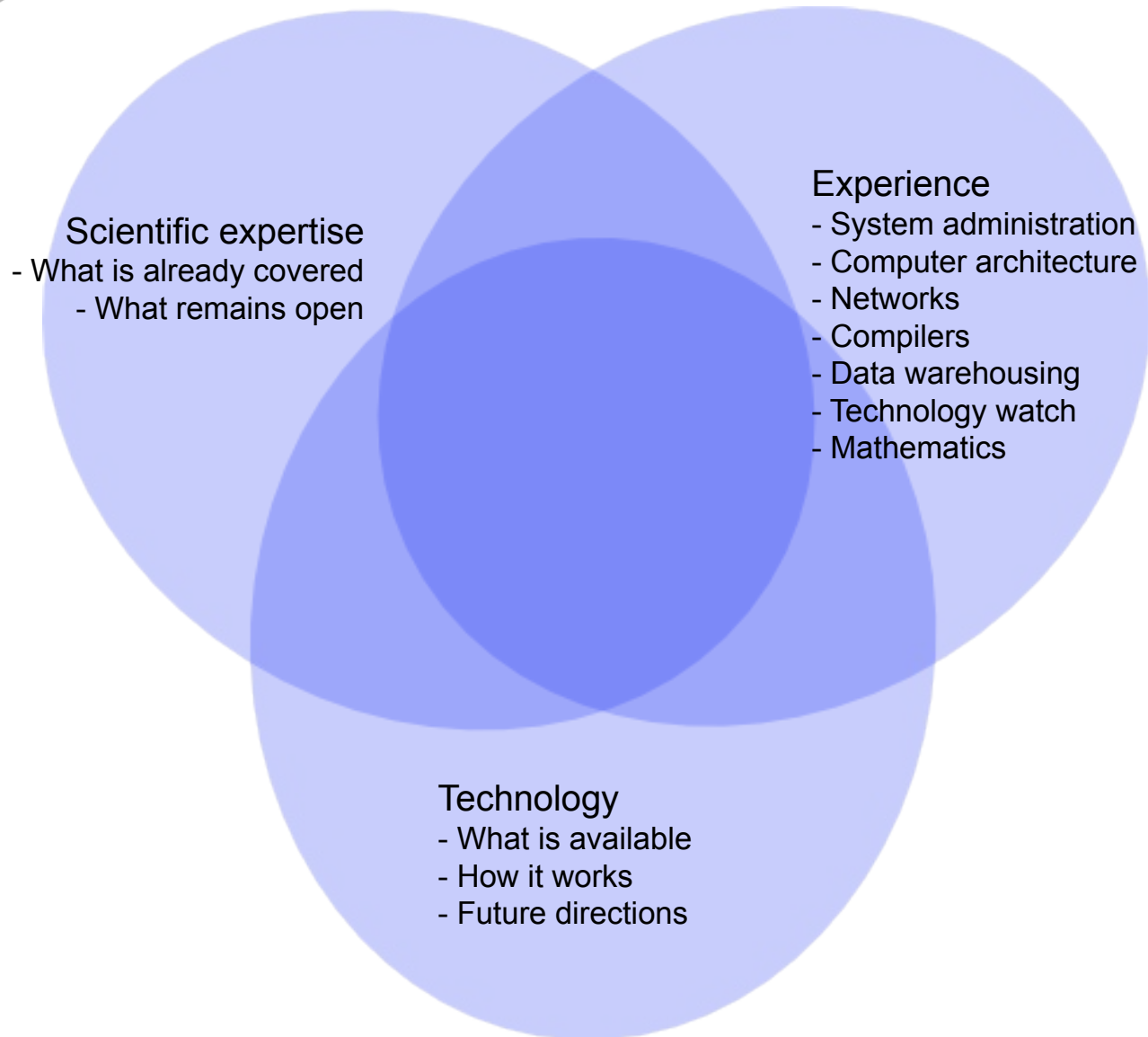


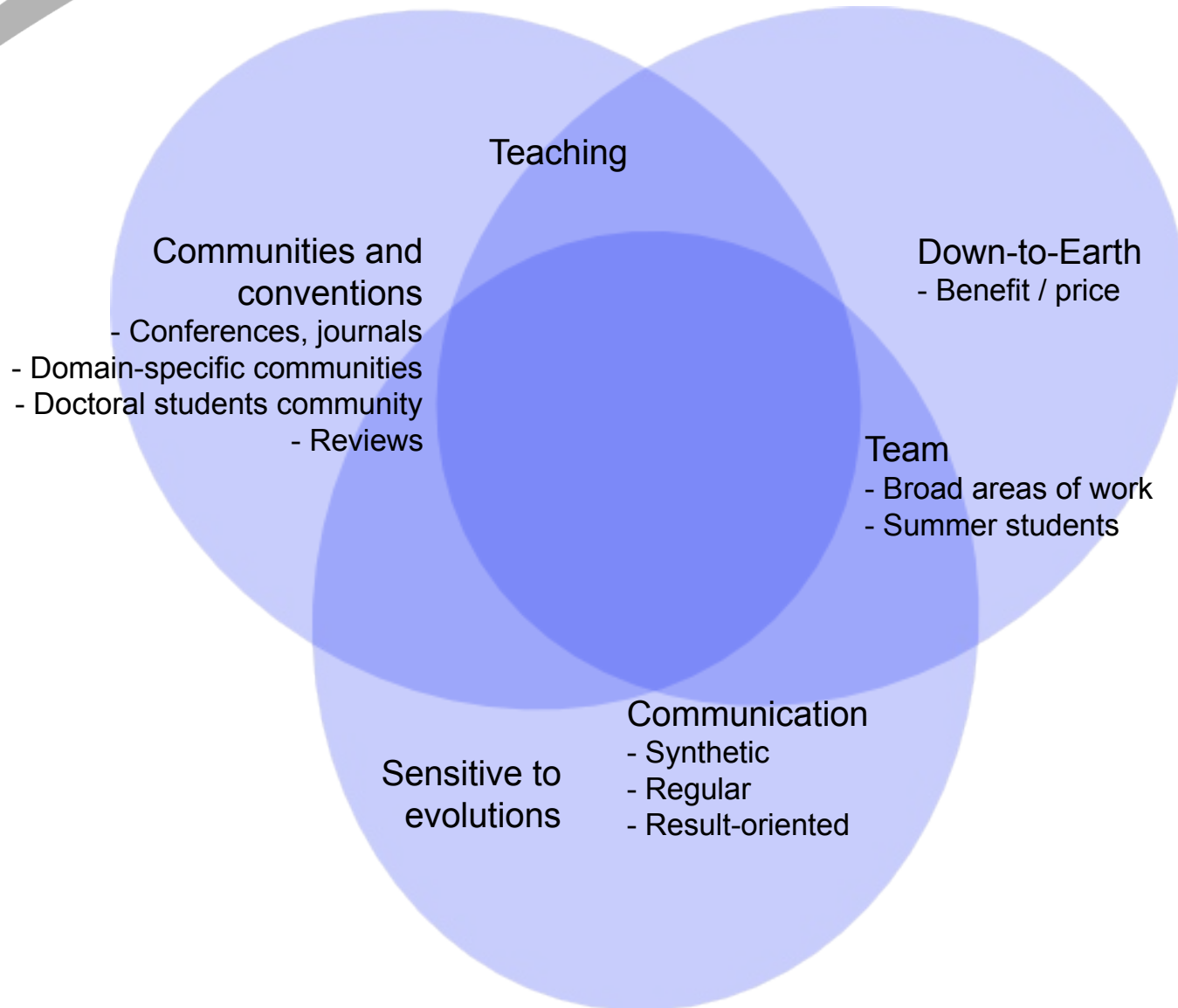


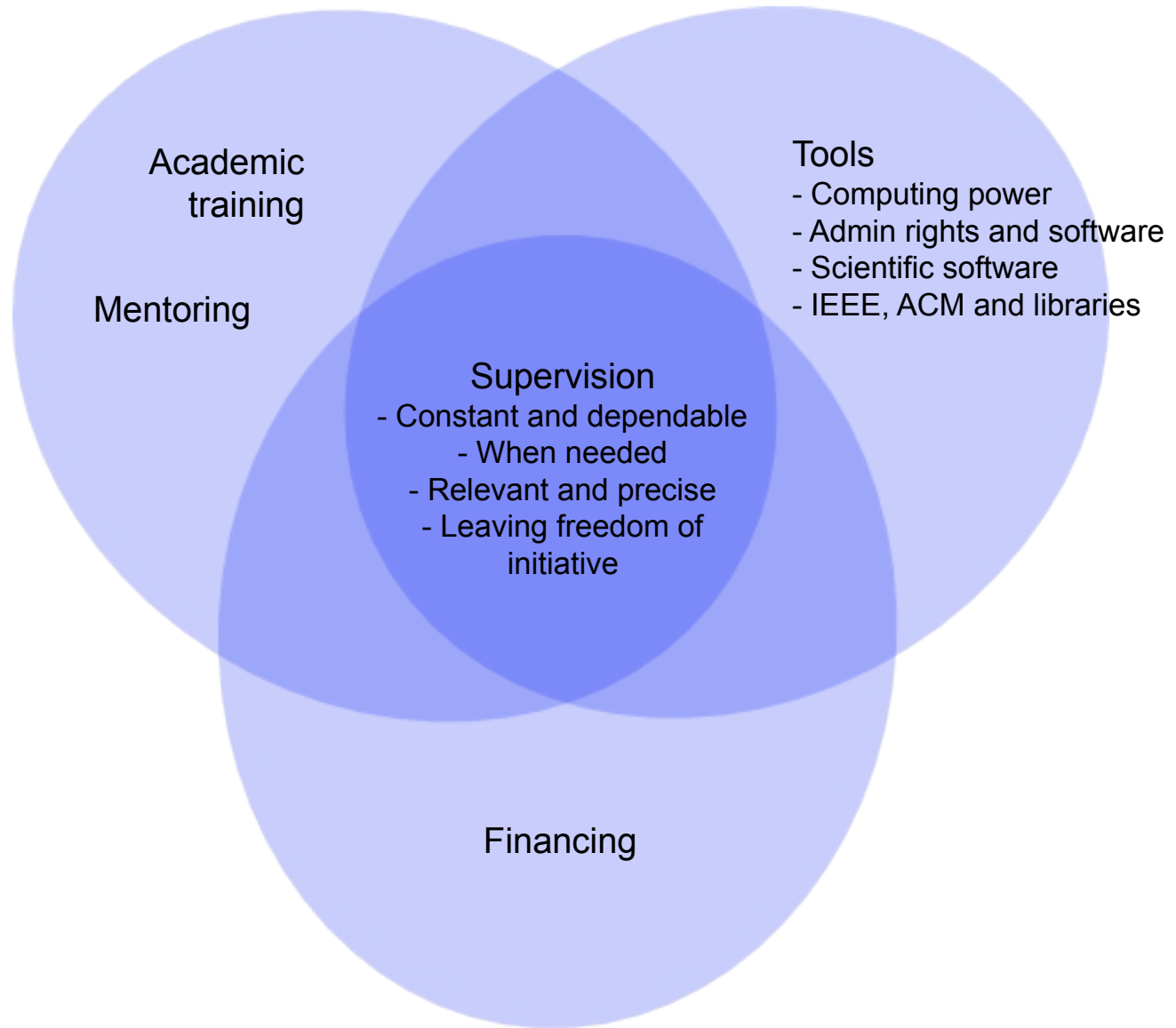












- Freedom of initiative was a specific agreement, not a rule in openlab.
