CERN Openlab Summer Student Program



Are you a B.Sc. or M.Sc. student (who will have completed at least three years of full-time studies at university level by next spring) in Computer Science, Mathematics, Engineering or Physics, interested in working on advanced IT projects for two full months during the summer? Then the CERN Openlab Summer Student Program might be for you!

CERN openlab is a public-private partnership between CERN and leading ICT companies. Its mission is to accelerate the development of solutions to be used by the worldwide LHC community. It runs a summer student program separate from the generic CERN Student Summer Program.

Here are the eligibility criteria:

- You must be a Bachelor or Master student in Computer Science, Physics, Mathematics or Engineering.
- You have completed, by summer 2015, at least three years of full-time studies at university level.
- You will remain registered as a student during your stay at CERN. If you expect to graduate during summer 2015, you are also eligible to apply.
- You have not worked at CERN before with any other status (Technical Student, Trainee, User...) for more than 3 months.
- A good knowledge of English is mandatory; knowledge of French would be an advantage.
