Before joining CERN openlab in 2013 he led the European Middleware Initiative (EMI) project responsible to develop and maintain a large part of the computing and data management software used by the Worldwide LHC Computing Grid (WLCG). He is a member of the Italian Board of Engineers, a Chartered Engineer of the British Engineering Council, and a member of IET and IEEE.
