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Since restarting in June 2015 after a two-year upgrade, the Large Hadron Collider (LHC) at CERN, the European Organisation for Nuclear Research, has been recording about 3GB of data per second, or about 25 petabytes ? that's 25 million gigabytes ? of data per year.
