At the same time, the students were also dedicated to their individual projects, which covered a diverse range of

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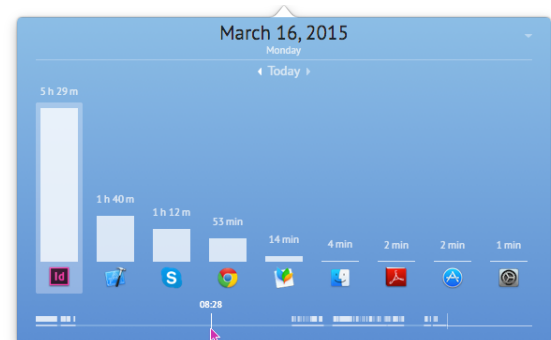
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topics, including high-performance computing, big data, visualisation and machine learning.
