Going as per your question , There are many foreign internships offered to both undergraduate and graduate students in India . I have done some research on this topic and your query demands the internships which consider the percentage system as a selection parameter rather than the Grades system. I should tell you that these foreign universities and firms where you seek internship do provide some flexibility when accounted for the conversion of these two evaluation scores . Here is a list of some prominent internships where you can think of applying in the future . Also some of them have varied terms in case of stipend , some do selections just for the learning sake while some pay you stipends depending on the job you are assigned there, technically speaking.

1. Summer Research Programme (The University of Auckland)

Applications are invited for Summer Research Scholarships. The University of Auckland is a university located in Auckland, New Zealand. It is the largest and highest-ranked university in the country, being ranked 82nd worldwide in the 2015/16 QS World University Rankings.

About the Internship: The interns will conduct a research project under supervision and co-author presentations at international conferences and academic journal articles. They will have good exposure to authentic case studies with participation in project meetings. Also, they will gain practice in data collection, analysis, literature reviews, interviewing techniques, and mind mapping. Interns will learn to use specialized software and acquire specialist laboratory and presentation skills.

Who can apply:

- Degree(s): Engineering (B.Tech/B.E/MCA), MBA, BBA & Commerce Humanities (B.A./M.A.) and Science and Law.
- Year of degree completion: 2016 or earlier, 2017.
- Only applicants who are available full time for a minimum duration of 3 month(s) can apply.
- Applicants should be available to start the internship on the mentioned date.
- Candidates pursuing their undergraduate and have completed at least two years of an undergraduate degree either at the time of application for this scholarship or by the time of take-up of the award in December 2016.

Candidates who are a postgraduate student either currently enrolled at a New Zealand university or enrolled in an undergraduate degree at an international institution in 2016.

2. Nanyang Technological University (NTU)

NTU is one of the leading universities of Singapore (and the world). Their Summer Research Internship (SRI) is conducted from 01 June 2016 to 22 July 2016 and students will be given a one-time allowance of SGD3000. 3. Summer Student Programme (CERN openlab)

Who should apply?

Bachelor or master students having completed (by the summer of attending) at least three years of full-time studies at university level in Computer Science, Engineering, Mathematics or Physics, interested in working on advanced IT projects for two full months (nine weeks) during the period June-September 2016 are welcome to apply.

4 .Michigan State University (inGear)

The INGEAR (Internship in Global Engineering & Advanced Research) program at Michigan State University offers summer research opportunities for high achieving undergraduates from international institutions. Funding is provided by the MSU College of Engineering, the MSU International Studies Program, and faculty mentors. During Summer 2016, the inGEAR program will take place on the MSU campus from May 23 through July 31, 2016. inGEAR is an "internship in graduate school" and provides participants with an early opportunity to become involved in research by working with faculty mentors in eight Engineering departments. Application deadline is Jan 15th, 2016.

5 .Carnegie Mellon University (RISS)

The Robotics Institute Summer Scholars (RISS) Program is an intensive summer research program for talented undergraduate students. Summer Scholars have the opportunity to participate in state-of-the-art research projects, interact with a diverse research team, and to be mentored by leading faculty and technical staff. The program introduces aspiring students to dynamic research resources and methods, RI graduate education programs and research projects. The Summer Scholars program lasts 11 weeks and begins in June and runs until mid-August. Only scholars who are available for the entirety of that time will be considered. Undergraduate students from both US and international institutions are eligible to apply by completing an online application with attachments (including resume, transcripts, recommendations, and personal statement) from December 1 through January 31 to the RI Summer Scholars Program.

6. Mitacs Globalink Research Internship

The Mitacs Globalink Research Internship is a competitive initiative for international undergraduates from Australia, Brazil, China, France, India, Germany, Mexico, Saudi Arabia, and Tunisia. From May to September of each year, top-ranked applicants participate in a 12-week research internship under the supervision of Canadian university faculty members in a variety of academic disciplines, from science, engineering and mathematics to the humanities and social sciences. Mitacs Globalink Research Internships are currently available at over 45 universities across Canada.

2017 student applicants must:

- Be at least 18 years of age
 - Be enrolled in full-time undergraduate or combined undergraduate/Master's programs
 - Have a minimum of one semester and a maximum of three semesters remaining in their program as of September 2017.
 - Meet the grade requirements for their country of study: For India (8/10)
- These were the few of the many current internships going on throughout the universities in the world .Hope that helps!!
