This is a unique public-private partnership between CERN and leading ICT companies. Its mission is to accelerate the development of leading-edge solutions to be used by the worldwide LHC community.

corresponding to nine weeks you will have the opportunity to attend [a series of](#)

**lectures** developed for the CERN openlab Summer Students, given by IT experts on advanced CERN-related topics. Included in the programme are also **visits** at the CERN facilities and experiments as well as other research laboratories and companies.

- 29 June to 28 August 2015
- 6 July to 4 September 2015

## Eligibility

- You must be a **Bachelor or Master student in Computer Science, Physics, Mathematics or Engineering.**
- You have **completed, by summer 2015, at least three years of full-time studies at university level.**
- You will remain registered as a student during your stay at CERN. If you expect to graduate during summer 2015, you are also eligible to apply.
- You have not worked at CERN before (ie as a User or a Technical Student).
- A good knowledge of English is mandatory; knowledge of French would be an advantage.

## Fellowship

- An allowance of **CHF 90 (EUR 75) per day** during contractual dates
- **Travel allowance** (on a lump sum basis)
- **Health insurance** Scheme during your stay
